

39th District Court Policy Regarding Use of Cell Phones or Other Portable Electronic Communication Devices

Pursuant to MCR 8.115(C), the following policy governs the use of cell phones or other portable electronic communication devices:


Cell phones or other portable electronic communication devices are allowed within the 39th District Court, including the courtrooms. However, cell phones or other portable electronic communication devices are to be silenced prior to entering any courtroom. Also, cell phones or other portable electronic communication devices are not to be used in the courtrooms.

Cell phones, cameras, or other portable electronic communication devices having cameras or videos are not to be used anywhere within the courthouse without permission of the court. At no time are photographs to be taken of any jurors or witnesses.

Failure to comply with this policy may result in a fine, including confiscation of the device, incarceration, or both for contempt of court.
