



Election Day Reminders



- ✓ Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- ✓ Call the Roseville City Clerk's Office at (586) 445-5443 with any questions.
- ✓ Michigan has a Voter Identification requirement at the polls. Voters are asked to present any of the following forms of ID:
 - Michigan Driver's License or State I.D. Card
 - Driver's License or State I.D. from any other state.
 - Federal or State Government issued photo identification.
 - U.S. Passport
 - Military ID with photo
 - Student Identification from high school or any institution of higher learning.
 - Tribal Identification card.
- ✓ Voters without acceptable form of I.D. or who failed to bring it with them to the polls can still vote. Voters would then complete and sign an affidavit attesting you are not in possession of a photo I.D. These ballots are included with all other ballots and counted on Election Day.
- ✓ Voter I.D. cards are for your reference and not required to vote.
- ✓ If you did not receive a Voter I.D. card or lost and would like a replacement please call the Roseville City Clerk's Office at (586) 445-5443
- ✓ All campaign workers must be at least 100 feet from any doorway used by voters to enter the building in which the polling place is located. Campaign signs, posters, or bumper stickers can be placed on cars or chairs, but must also be at least 100 feet from the entrance.
- ✓ Any campaign material must be removed, covered or put away when entering the polls to vote.
- ✓ You are not required to vote an entire ballot. You may pick and choose the races or ballot questions you wish to vote on. Skipping sections does not invalidate your ballot.
